## Create the Treasure Box from the Novel Like Magic by Elaine Vickers (Harper)

## Instructions

To make your treasure box you will need:
Glue for decoupage
Large flat paint brush for glue
Small paint brush for touch-up
Scissors
ArtMinds Wooden Book Box
Touch-up paint in 2 colors: Folk Art 417 Teddy Bear Brown and Folk Art 515 Vintage White or equivalent colors.


1. Print out pages. Make sure the PDF is printing scaled at $100 \%$.
2. Cut out pieces. Each page is labeled in the top left corner with where it is supposed to be placed on the art box.
3. Use glue and paintbrush to decoupage each piece to the corresponding side. There will be overlap on the spine. Make sure to put this overlap to the far right almost touching the hinges on the front cover so that it covers the whole spine.
4. Let glue dry according to the glue bottle's instructions.
5. Touch up any places the paper doesn't cover on the exterior with paint color 417 Teddy Bear Brown. Allow to dry.
6. Use paint color 515 Vintage White to paint the "pages" part of the book box. Use the same color to touch up areas on the interior that the paper didn't cover. Allow to dry.
7. Fill with treasures and share with a friend!
